Know that teachers will continue to reach out to parents if they notice students have not been engaging.

<u>Google Classroom Links</u>--If you are having difficulties with teachers' links not working in Google Classroom, try logging out of all other Google accounts, as having more than one Google account open will limit access to certain links.

Important Update from Our School Nurse--The nurses of Suffield Public Schools will be offering a drive through medication pickup at each school on Wednesday April 8, 2020 from 4-5:30pm. This will be the ONLY time medication may be picked up from the schools. Please make arrangements accordingly.

In order to maintain recommended social distancing, we will be organizing medications that will be readily available for pickup as you pull up to the school. At this time, no one will be allowed to enter the building. The nurses will be stationed inside the foyer of the school with the medications and 2 tables will be set up outside of the school for medication pickup.

School Nurse News

As you pull up to the school, please maintain the recommended 6 feet of space between parties. You will verbalize who you are picking medication up for and fill out the medication pickup form on table #1. At that time, the nurse will retrieve your medication and place it on table #2. You may then take your child's medication and return to your vehicle.

If you are picking up a controlled medication, the nurses will be conducting a pre-count prior to pick up. You will count and sign the 2^{nd} signature of the form on table #2. If anyone other than the parent/guardian is picking up a controlled medication, please let your nurse know ahead of time or the medication will not be permitted to leave the building.

Please email Mrs Dingley at mdingley@suffield.org if you plan on picking up your child's medication so that we can best be prepared for this new event. If you have questions, please email your school nurse individually as we do not have access to our voicemail from home.
