D. Legal Responsibilities of the Board of Education

The powers, duties, and the responsibilities of the Board of Education originate from state statutes. The Board of Education shall have authority to take all necessary or advisable action to meet its responsibilities including, but not limited to the following:

- Conduct all business at a legal meeting of the Board.
- To elect and review a Superintendent in accordance with state statutes.
- To consider and adopt an annual budget, prepared by the Superintendent.
- To establish all policies for the district.
- To make reasonable provision to implement the educational interests of the State, as defined by law.
- To take other actions required or permitted by law.
