High School Code of Ethics

It is the duty of all concerned with school athletics:

1. To emphasize the proper ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
2. To eliminate all possibilities which tend to destroy the best values of the game.
3. To stress the values derived from playing the game fairly and uphold all rules and regulations for games and practices.
4. To show cordial courtesy to visiting teams and officials.
5. To treat all players and coaches with respect and courtesy.
6. To respect the integrity and judgment of sports officials.
7. To achieve a thorough understanding and acceptance of the rules of the game and the standards of eligibility as established by the CIAC and SHS.
8. To encourage leadership, use of initiative and good judgment by the players on the team.
9. To recognize that the purpose of athletics is to develop and promote the physical, mental, moral, social and emotional well-being of the individual players.

Failure to comply with Sportsmanship Regulation 6145.22 REG may result in disciplinary action by the coach, athletic director and/or administration.
