(2) Class Size

The Board of Education believes that appropriate class size is vital to the learning process, but there is no single number of students which is inherently right for all classes. The objectives of a particular course and the methods used in the program will determine class size.

Student-centered learning activities and a high degree of individualized attention to each student are high priorities in our school district. Appropriate class size must be determined according to the nature of the instruction, the academic ability of the students in the class, any special education needs of enrolled students, the curriculum, and the methods of instruction.
