E. Instructional Arrangements

(6) Homework/Make-Up Work

Homework assignments are an integral part of student learning and aligned with BEST practices in amount and degree of difficulty for student ages, grade levels and abilities. Assignments requiring research outside of the classroom and written reports are encouraged.

Guidelines for homework assignments approved by the Superintendent of Schools shall be used in course lesson planning, course objectives, and made available to students and parents.

Each school will publish its homework procedures in the student handbook to be reviewed by the Suffield Board of Education yearly.
