In accordance with the provisions of Section 10-19(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes, it is the policy of the Board of Education to provide, during the regular school day, planned ongoing and systematic instruction on Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS). Various school district curricula, including health, science, and social studies, shall include information on AIDS – both its cause and prevention.

Students will be exempt from instruction on acquired immune deficiency syndrome upon written request of the parent or guardian in accordance with state statutes.
