

**Series 7000 – Construction****1. Occupying****G. Naming of Facility**

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education to consider the naming of school facilities using the following criteria:

- A. The Board of Education shall act as a committee of the whole in determining whether or not to name any facility or other area under their jurisdiction.
  - 1. The individual must have attained prominence at the local, state and/or national level for their participation in and success as a public servant.
  - 2. Where appropriate, the Board of Education may consider naming portions of their facilities and other areas under their control for individuals and/or organizations who, through their significant endorsement, have made possible the construction of said facilities or other areas.
- B. For the purposes of naming school facilities, the Board will follow this sequence:
  - 1. Announcement and distribution of proposed name(s) at a Board of Education meeting.
  - 2. Opportunity offered to concerned groups or individuals to react to name(s).
  - 3. Discussion and final action by the Board on name(s).

The final vote to adopt or not to adopt name(s) shall follow by at least 90 days from the meeting at which the proposed name(s) are first placed on the agenda.
