2. Members

C. Board Member Development

The Board of Education places a high priority on the importance of planned and continued professional development for its members. The Board shall plan or attend training sessions designed to assist members in their efforts to improve their skills and knowledge related to Board work. All Board members should participate in at least one professional development activity per year.

Funds shall be budgeted annually to support Board member development. The public shall be kept informed about the Board's continuing in-service education and about the anticipated short and long range benefits to our schools.

The following are examples of appropriate professional development opportunities:

1. Participation in school board conferences, workshops and conventions held by Connecticut Association of Boards of Education or National School Boards Association.
2. District-sponsored training sessions for Board members.
