

Series 9000 – Bylaws of the Board

2. Members

E. Board Member Protection

Members of the Suffield Board of Education shall be indemnified against any liability, cost or expense incurred by reason of their capacity in serving on the Board, to the full extent permitted under Connecticut state law.

Suffield Public Schools shall maintain adequate insurance to protect the district and its Board of Education against loss because of fire, damage to school property, loss to other property, or general liability resulting as a responsibility of the school district, and hold harmless its Board and staff while acting on behalf of the school district.
