School transition refers to the transition, or movement, of students from one level to the next. Parents and students can expect some changes to service delivery/model of specially-designed individual instruction plans as their student(s) moves from one school to another as expectations at varying school levels differ.

Following a brief opening by the Co-Interim Directors, parents will be invited to attend break-out sessions with special education staff from each school. During these sessions parents will receive information as well as materials that describe programs and services, put faces to names, and offer opportunities to have generalized questions addressed. There will be repeat sessions offered for those families with more than one child transitioning next year.
